SCHEDULE OL-2 OUTDOOR LIGHTING SERVICE

PURPOSE

To provide revenue for patrons' electric service and capital from the patrons. In compliance with the Cooperative's principles and bylaws, revenue for electric service is equal to the cost of service provided. All money in excess of the cost of providing electric service is capital, at the moment of receipt, and will be credited to each patron's individual capital account.

AVAILABILITY

Available in all territory served by the Seller in accordance with the Service Rules and Regulations of the Seller on file with the Georgia Public Service Commission.

APPLICABILITY

Applicable only to outdoor lighting by ballast operated high intensity discharge fixtures and poles conforming to the seller's specifications for dusk to dawn lighting. Service will be rendered only at locations that, solely in the opinion of the seller, are readily accessible for maintenance and where standard secondary voltage is presently available.

*Fixtures served by underground wiring will be available at these rates (excluding certain residential areas served by overhead distribution) where required buried cable does not exceed, on the average, 125 feet per fixture. A contribution-in-aid-of construction will be charged amounting to **\$6.00** per foot of the excess buried cable over 125 feet per fixture. Where underground wiring is desired, and paving or other obstructions exist, the consumer will be required to perform all trenching, install duct furnished by the seller, backfill, and complete the paving to the mutual satisfaction of all parties concerned.

Section C – Explanatory Notes

- (1) A volume use discount as set forth below will be allowed on all fixtures in excess of ten fixtures per consumer prorated according to the number and size of fixtures.

- (2) Bills for different premises will not be combined in calculating this charge. A premise is defined as a single contiguous area either owned or controlled by the consumer.
- (3) Where the contract for outdoor lighting service under this schedule is executed with the State or a local government or any of their agencies, the above discount will apply to all fixtures.
- (4) The seller will bill any fixtures listed above at the rate for the same size fixture shown on the column headed "Existing Overhead Distribution Wood Pole" provided the consumer or other interested party, makes a non-refundable contribution in-aid-of-construction of the amount set forth in parentheses for each fixture.
- (5) Where it is necessary for the Seller to install additional poles for the exclusive purpose of rendering outdoor lighting service, a nominal monthly charge shall be made for each pole. In lieu of the monthly pole charge, a consumer may, at his option, make a non-refundable contribution in-aid-of construction in the amount shown in parentheses above for each pole.

Part II – Customer Owned Equipment - Unmetered

Service charge **\$24.00** per location.

Notes:

- (1) Carroll Electric Membership Corporation may, at its option, verify kWh by installing a kWh meter or load limiting device.
- (2) The number and location of service points shall be specified by the Corporation.
- (3) In no case shall the Corporation spend more than two-and-one-half times estimated annual revenue to be derived from this service. The term "customer owned equipment" means complete ownership by the customer of all facilities including poles, fixtures, circuits and disconnect devices up to a point of connect of the Company's supply lines. The customer shall provide a suitable mounting and wiring for a Company supplied photo electric receptacle and a weather-proof enclosure, if needed, for any company supplied relay. The Company, may at its option, require the customer to supply the photo electric control.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

The above rates are net. The bill is payable upon receipt and due by the date shown on the bill.

TERM OF CONTRACT

A period of not less than one (1) year for 100 watt high pressure sodium light and a period of not less than five (5) years for all other lights.

FACILITIES CHARGE RIDER

A facilities charge will be added to the basic rate for the investment in facilities in excess of that which is normally required to furnish demand and energy to customers under this rate schedule. The facilities charge will be calculated as the dollar investment in facilities times a fixed monthly charge rate.

TAXES

In addition, the Consumer will pay the amount of any sales, use, franchise or utility taxes for charges now or hereafter applicable to or arising out of the service rendered or made available under this schedule, which tax shall be added to each bill; unless the Consumer furnishes satisfactory evidence that it is exempt here from.
